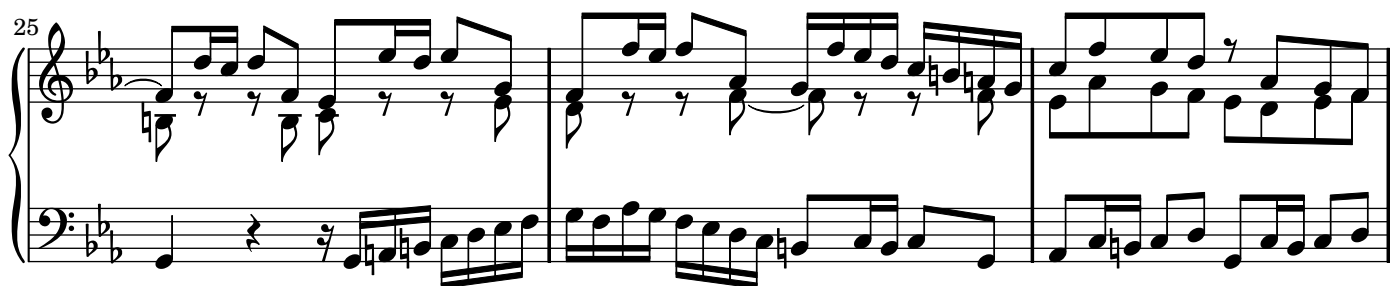
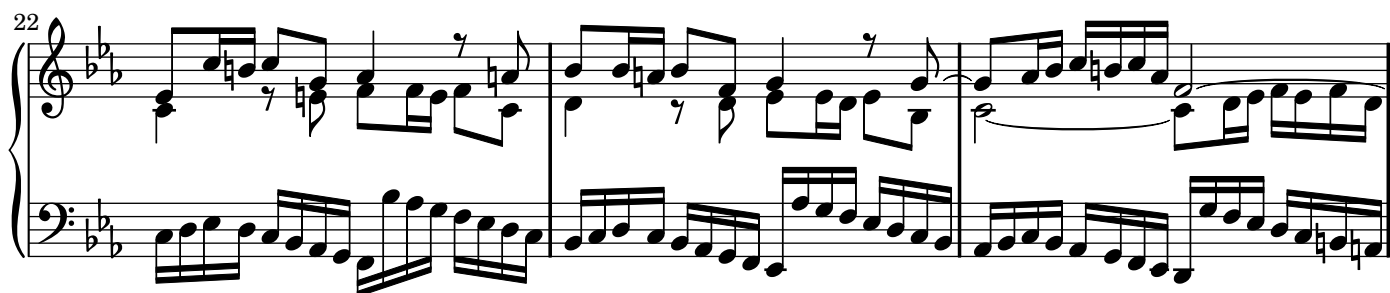
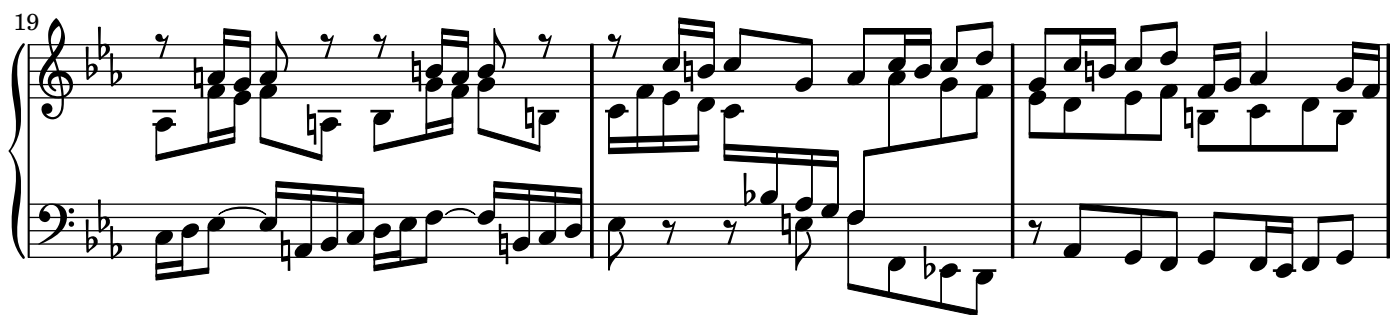


# Fuga a 3 voci

Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750)

BWV 847
